Immunization bill- The state assembly passed it and the bill is currently in the Senate.

Report State legislative liaison- Jo Hochman

The League of Municipalities meets next Friday, and many people are working on the pending legislation on Marijuana. It is broken down into many aspects approximately 25 different categories that will be affected. There are many pros and cons. Discussion ensued regarding its legalization. there is currently no date pending for passing this legislation.

<u>Membership Committee</u> - Nancy Wilson, Steve Papenberg and Paul Roman.

Wild Apricot- Cost will be \$540/year and \$60/month. This program accepts payment, enrolls and tracks membership. It will require online enrollment in order to enable tracking of the membership numbers. Wild Apricot may also support the on-line board certification process.

Question: Most of our membership payments and enrollment occurs by way of municipal vouchers. If Wild Apricot is unable to process municipal vouchers as the form of payment, we may not be able to benefit from their services. Steve and Paul will research these issues and report back at the next meeting.

Steve Reported- One difficulty in recruiting membership, is that enrollment literature does not always reach local B.O.H. members; therefore, he will break down membership by county and reach out to them "face-to-face" to identify a specific individual to communicate with.

<u>PHACE-</u> Paul Roman, Steve Papenberg

Steve attended a meeting at the Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy. Guest speaker Dr. Jackson from California will be meeting with the new commissioner for health and the governor. Copies of the "Transition Letter" were handed out to board members while one was provided to Dr. Jackson at that meeting. A survey is pending from Kevin Sumner regarding the formalization of PHACE. A meeting with the Nicholson Foundation is still pending. PHACE is still planning to attend one of our meetings in the future to further explain this collaborative. Legislative days are confirmed as June 11th and June 14th. The Office of Local Public Health is meeting on June 18th at 3100 Quakerbridge Rd.

Treasurer's Report- Stephen Papenberg

A request was made for the approval of two pending expenditures: a. Travelers Insurance \$271.00. b. Donation of \$50.00 to the Abramson Cancer Institute of the University of Pennsylvania on memorial of Nancy Wilson's Mother.
